How Franklin Graham (Billy Graham's son), Unknowingly Blasphemed Jesus Christ at Trump's Inauguration

And the whole world agreed with him.

Unfortunately, Christians of today don't really STUDY the Bible. Some actually read the Bible daily, but mainly they read what their church tells them to read. They don't really STUDY on their own.

Even though Timothy tells us to

"Hold fast the form of sound words. . . " 2 Tim 1:13

the average Christian of today never studies the *words*. If they did, they would have jumped out of their chairs on Trump Inauguration day, when none other than Franklin Graham, the son of world famous Billy Graham, blasphemed Jesus Christ (who IS God – in human form), by misreading the Bible.

It is clear that neither Franklin Graham, nor, most probably, his father, have ever truly studied the "words" of the Bible. If they had, they would NOT have dishonored God in such a disparaging way: they worship God as a mere human being, who is unable to accomplish what He came to earth to do.

Here is what Franklin Graham read during the Inaugural service:

"God wants all people to be saved and come to a knowledge of the truth."

1 Tim 2:4

Here is the way that verse is **mistranslated** in the vast majority of the versions of the Bible, 16 versions:

New International Version

who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

New Living Translation who **wants** everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

English Standard Version

who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Berean Study Bible

who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Berean Literal Bible

who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

New American Standard Bible

who **desires** all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Holman Christian Standard Bible

who wants everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

International Standard Version

who wants all people to be saved and to come to know the truth fully.

NET Bible

since he wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

New Heart English Bible

who desires all people to be saved and come to full knowledge of the truth.

GOD'S WORD® Translation

He wants all people to be saved and to learn the truth.

New American Standard 1977

who **desires** all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Jubilee Bible 2000

who desires that all men be saved and come unto the knowledge of the truth.

American Standard Version

who would have all men to be saved, and come to the knowledge of the truth.

Darby Bible Translation

who **desires** that all men should be saved and come to [the] knowledge of [the] truth.

Weymouth New Testament

who **is willing** for all mankind to be saved and come to a full knowledge of the truth. (this is a passive cop-out)

World English Bible

who **desires** all people to be saved and come to full knowledge of the truth.

The word "want" doesn't appear in the Interlinear Bible, nor in Strong's Concordance under 1 Tim 2:4.

The word "desire" is 1971= epipotheo, epipothesis, epipothia, meaning an *intense longing*. That is NOT the word that appears in the Greek Scriptures under 1 Tim 2:4.

The proper word in this passage is *thelo*, a derivative of the word *thelema*, which means **will or determination** – NOT a mere "desire."

God is DETERMINED for ALL mankind to be saved, and come to a knowledge of the truth. God is not wishy-washy. He NEVER fails!

Only the following five versions translate the words correctly.

King James Bible

Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

Douay-Rheims Bible

Who will have all men to be saved, and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Webster's Bible Translation

Who will have all men to be saved, and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Young's Literal Translation

who doth will all men to be saved, and to come to the full knowledge of the truth;

Concordant Literal Translation

Who wills that all mankind be saved and come into a realization of the truth.

Why is this so important?

The Bible tells us that Jesus came to TAKE AWAY the sin of the WORLD! And He WILL DO what He came TO DO!

"Behold the Lamb of God, who TAKES AWAY the sin of the world." John 1:29

"God is the Savior of ALL mankind. . ." 1 Tim 4:10

"I watch over My Word to perform it." Jeremiah 1:12

"For no word from God will ever fail." Luke 11:37

"With men this is impossible, but with God, ALL is possible." Matt 19:26

"God is Love" 1 John 4:8 and "Love NEVER fails." 1 Cor 13:8

But churches don't believe the Bible

Here is what Franklin Graham, Billy Graham and virtually ALL churches believe about God and His salvation: That Jesus Christ will NOT be able to do what He came to do – "take away the sin of the world" and "save ALL mankind."

This is a quote from a "Christian" web page that articulates what virtually every Christian denomination believes:

"God genuinely **desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.** Yet in "the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Eph. 3:11), He chose only the elect "out of the world" (John 17:6), and passed over the rest, leaving them to the damning consequences of their sin (cf.. Rom. 1:18–32). The culpability for their damnation rests entirely on them because of their sin and rejection of God. God is not to blame for their unbelief.

"Since **God desires all men to be saved**, we are not required to ascertain that a person is elect before praying for that person's salvation. God alone knows who all the elect are (2 Tim. 2:19). We may pray **on behalf of all men** with full assurance that such prayers are **good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior.** After all, "the Lord is gracious and merciful; slow to anger and great in loving-kindness. The Lord is good to all, and His mercies are over all His works" (Ps. 145:8–9).

Their conclusion: God would LIKE to save all mankind – but He is UNABLE to do it! The churches believe that Jesus Christ will FAIL in His mission to "take AWAY the SIN of the (whole) WORLD." John 1:29

But God WILL Save ALL mankind!

You would think there would be an uproar by Christians when Franklin Graham not only read an inaccurate translation that CHANGED the Bible, but he blasphemed God, and reduced Him down to the status of a mere mortal by saying that God is NOT ABLE, through Jesus Christ, to do what He came to do, that Jesus will fail in His mission, that Jesus' death on the cross is not sufficient to save the world, even though God says what He WILL do, and what He is
